Amehlo am ablowu/aluhlaza/antsundu. *(My eyes are blue/green/brown.)*

#### Umzimba *(body)*

#### uses of "na"

- na- means "and" "with"

**NB:** can only use na- with NOUNS

##### 1. NA- (and)

Add na- to front of noun and make necessary changes.

For example: na- + ilekese = nelekese *(and sweet)*

na- + ubisi = nobisi *(and milk)*

na- + iitships = neetships *(and chips)*

na- + amanzi = namanzi *(and water)*

##### 2. NA- (with)

Add na- to the front of the noun referring to people or animals.

For example: na- + iikati = neekati *(with cats)*

na- + umama = nomama *(with mom)*

na- +inja = nenja *(with a dog)*

na- + abafundi = nabafundi *(with students)*
